Theme: Celebrating Initiatives to Promote Nursing across the Globe: WHO's Year of the Nurse & Midwife, National Academy of Medicine, Robert Wood Johnson's Nursing 2020-2030 and NursingNow! Campaign.

Description:

This day-long meeting celebrates the world wide initiatives that promote nursing. The World Health Organization's Executive board designated 2020 as 'The Year of the Nurse & Midwife', in honor of the 200th birth anniversary of Florence Nightingale. The 'NursingNOW' Campaign is a three-year effort (2018-2020) to improve health globally by raising the status of nursing. The National Academy of Medicine, Robert Wood Johnson's Future of Nursing 2020-2030 charts a path for the nursing profession as leaders in developing a culture of health, reducing health disparities, and improving the health and well-being of the United States population in the 21st century. This event is co-sponsored by the Global Nursing Caucus and the MGH Institute of Health Professions School of Nursing Center for Climate Change, Climate Justice, and Health.
